Mr Teo Siong Seng is Managing Director of Pacific International Lines (Pte) Ltd, one of the largest shipowners and operators in Southeast Asia with a focus on Asia-Africa and the Middle East. He is also the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of PIL's listed subsidiary, Singamas Container Holdings Ltd, Hongkong. He holds executive directorships of several PIL subsidiaries and joint venture companies whose activities include ship owning, liner shipping, ship agencies, shipping fund, freight forwarding, container manufacturing, ship recycling, oil & gas, container depot/terminal operation, warehousing, logistics centre, real estate and travel.

In Singapore, he plays an active role in promoting the shipping industry, serving as Chairman of Singapore Maritime Institute Board of Directors and Governing Council, and The Standard Club Asia Ltd.

Mr Teo is also a Nominated Member of Parliament, and as the voice of the business community he functions as a bridge between the business community and Government.

Prior to his appointment as Chairman of SBF, Mr Teo was its Vice Chairman from 2010, representing the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry, where he served as President from 2009 to 2013. He holds several other appointments including Board Member, Duke-NUS Graduate Medical School Governing Board; Board Member of Sino-Singapore Guangzhou Knowledge City Investment Development Co. Ltd; Director, Business China; Independent Director, China Shipping Container Lines Company Ltd; and Standing Council Member, China Overseas Exchange Association, Beijing. Mr Teo is also the Honorary Consul of The United Republic of Tanzania to Singapore, and is the Joint Chairman of the Africa South East Asia Chamber of Commerce & Industry.

Mr Teo was awarded the Public Service Medal (2010). He graduated with a First Class Honours Degree in Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering.
